1. Mr. Ken Knolhoff called the meeting to order at 7:30
2. Attendance:

3. Mr. Jansen made a motion to approve the minutes from the March 11, 2026 meeting. Mr. Hilmes seconded the motion. The motion passed by voice vote.
4. The maintenance activities of the previous month were discussed.
5. Mr. Diekemper gave the committee a copy of the latest draft of the new building plans. Mr. Knolhoff made a motion to send this to the facilities committee. Mr. Jansen seconded the motion. The motion passed.
6. Mr. Diekemper reported on the options for a used boom lift.
7. Mr. Behrens gave the committee the results from the county's oil letting. Mr. Hilmes made a motion to have this placed on the board's agenda for approval of the low bidders. Mr. Knolhoff seconded the motion.. The motion passed by voice vote.
8. The committee discussed the conditions for a maintenance agreement for Main Street and St. Rose Road in St. Rose. Mr. Behrens will get this to St Rose for their review.
9. The proposed repairs for Walnut Street were discussed. They anticipate starting in May with the City of Breese helping.
10. The contractor has started the bridge replacement on Lake Road. The project is ahead of schedule and might be completed by the end of May.
11. The highway department personnel have completed their first aid training that was required by the Department of Labor.
12. Mr. Behrens reported that Breese Township desires improvements to Holy Cross Lane and is looking for funding. HMG Engineers will look at the potential for this being eligible for HSIP funds.
13. Mr. Behrens said that the Village of Huey is asking for help with replacing a culvert. This is possible by using county bridge funds. Mr. Behrens will contact the Village concerning this replacement.
