APPROVAL OF MINUTES

ANIMAL CONTROL ADMINISTRATOR REPORT - KENNY “DOC” BROWN

- The Expenditure and Budget Status Reports were reviewed.
- Doc reported that the 501 (c) (3) is in its final stage. Deb Wesselmann will be the registered agent.
- A discussion was held regarding feedback that was received on the Intergovernmental Agreements. It was decided that in the event a municipality does not sign an agreement, a per call fee will be charged.

ANIMAL CONTROL WARDEN REPORT - TONY PETREA

- Tony distributed his reports which showed that one citation was issued. There were 22 online rabies tag payments, 24 online spay/neuter clinic reservations, and 53 calls were run in the month of February.
- There were 10 dogs and 13 cats taken into the facility in February and at the current time, there are 9 dogs and 0 cats in the facility.
- Tony said that he will prepare an ordinance regarding the option for municipalities to pay per capita or a per call fee and will have State’s Attorney review it.
- A discussion was held regarding bodycams. Tony stated that he feels it would be a good idea to use them to support what really happens.
- Tony said that he had the fence requoted, and the price did not change. It would be \$12,822 bolted and \$15,782 core drilled into the concrete.
